

The Aim of the CILO role is to:

- Provide **Education and Outreach** services to researchers, start-ups and established companies in the Medical Technology sector
- Identify and evaluate strategic capabilities of clinical infrastructure for Medical Technology investigations in Ireland
- Advise and signpost support to Irish researchers, start-up and established companies on regulatory requirements
- Support infrastructure for **international market access** in the Medical Technology sectors
- Work closely with other MedTech supporting research organistaions such as the **Health Innovation Hub Ireland**, HIHI
- Provide policy and benchmarking advice to key clinical research stakeholders and industry stakeholders
